Further Notice of Conversations

It seems to me that two extremes must be avoided:

- 1) To act superior and distant by refusing to participate in conversations. This indicates a lack of confidence in and even disdain for others:
- 2) To pretend to be interested by babbling and joking and giving no one a chance to get a word in edgewise. This indicates a shallow frivolity.

Recall how St. Louis showed little appreciation for side remarks, especially at table. He feared that his other dinner guests might get the impression that they were the object of such asides. "Anyone in company," he used to say, "ought to let everyone profit from his conversation. As for important subjects, this is neither the time nor the place for their discussion.
